Stand aside Sherwood Forest, we're transporting you to The Forest of Havering. Expect more local jokes than you can shoot an arrow at, and enough swashbuckling to send any Christmas humbug packing. Returning to the once-glittering Clacton-on-Sea, washed-up magician Bazza Cadabra is ready for a final comeback, determined to reclaim the spotlight and prove he’s still got what it takes 20 years on. But every trick has a price.

This comeback isn’t just about applause. At the heart of Bazza’s ambition is something far more fragile, his bond with his son. Bound by shared secrets, old tricks, and unfinished business, their reunion sparks hope, rivalry, and the possibility of something extraordinary. Relaxed Performances (RX)

Relaxed performances are ideal for anyone who would benefit from a calmer environment, particularly those with Autism Spectrum Disorder, sensory or communication disorders, or learning disabilities. They incorporate adjusted sound and lighting, mindful staging, and thoughtful front-of-house arrangements. As with dementia-friendly shows, flexible seating is available in the Main House.
